

Navigation Course Instructions

Things you and your partner will need:

- GPS
- Compass
- Know your 100m pace count
- Pen or Pencil
- Course Book
- Headlamp or Flashlight

Before you start:

- The Starting Point is at a lamp post in the staff parking area west of the classroom, now labeled point #000.
- Add an entry in your course booklet for each point that has an outgoing clue from point #000.
- Use the index on page 3 to keep track of the points for which you have clues and to track which points you have visited.
- Check out before you leave the classroom on the check-out/in form
- Be back by about 10pm
- Check in when you return on the same form.

- You will likely not be able to complete the course tonight. Not to worry, we will have time on Saturday and Sunday to finish.
- Some of the flags for this course are off campus. None of the flags are on private property. It is not necessary to climb fences to reach the flags.
